ORDER SETTING SHOW CAUSE HEARING

Plaintiff's Motion to Show Cause Why a Preliminary Injunction should not issue came before the Court ex parte on November 20, 2002. Plaintiff appeared through his attorney, Arthur C. Johnson.

Based on the Motion, and Points and Authorities, the Complaint on file, and the Affidavit of Plaintiff Mark Reed, the Court finds that Plaintiff is likely entitled to the relief sought in his filed Complaint; that ORS 672.525 and OAR 809-050-0030 appear, as applied to the facts of this case, to

1 violate the constitutional rights of Plaintiff, and that if Defendants are not immediately restrained
2 from enforcing ORS 672.525 and OAR 809-050-0030, Plaintiff Reed will continue to suffer
3 irreparable injury, loss, and damage from being denied his right to express himself freely and to
4 provide public testimony on geologic issues of public concern.

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

6 1. Defendants shall appear before this court on Nov 26 at 10 a.m., Courtroom 306,
7 Lane County Courthouse, and show cause, if any there be, why the activity described
8 above should not be restrained during the pendency of this action.
